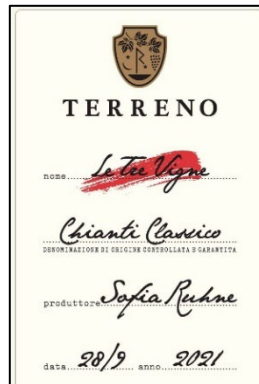


Terreno Chianti Classico

Chianti Classico Le Tre Vigne 2021

The organic Terreno 2021 Chianti Classico Le Tre Vigne (with 30,000 bottles made) sees fruit sourced from three separate estate parcels with a mix of different soils that are typical of the region. This vintage is a little more intense and deserves special attention thanks to the purity of its flavors and its bright intensity. This wine offers more fruit weight and a velvety consistency.

Bright ruby with garnet shimmer. Opens with notes of cinnamon and cardamom, fine savouriness, followed by ripe cherry fruit. Juicy at the front, fine fruit, then opens up with grippy, hearty tannins, firm drive on the finish, somewhat rough.

Deep, lustrous ruby. A glorious nose of lifted cherry and raspberry with hints of exotic spice. Lush, tangy cherry fruit, with gripping tannins adding tension. Great purity and focus.

Terreno's annata now bears the name Tre Vigne, acknowledging the addition of the estate's new Sillano plot in Montefioralle, which is blended with fruit from the Bonille and Terreno vineyards on the right bank of Greve. Warm summer berries are interlaced with scents of savoury herbs, cinnamon and clove. There is a fullness of fruit and flavour with a buoyance of spirit. Luscious dark cherry is countered by concentrated succulent acidity and fine, chalky tannins lend a fluid shape.
