Bright golden-tinged yellow. Deep aromas of lemon balm, apple pie, almond paste and tangerine. More saline and savoury than the Le Piaole, this is thick, rich and really quite good. Extremely long on the layered textured finish. Natural yeasts, nine months in stainless steel and five to six more in bottle before going on sale are part of this wine's selling points. Balluccio is the name of the grandfather of the current owner: the name balluccio is from "ballo" or dance because he liked to organize parties where people appropriately enough danced. Drinking window: 2024-2033.

The organic Tenuta dell'Ugolino 2021 Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico Superiore Vigneto del Balluccio opens to measured aromas of citrus, honeydew melon and crushed stone. I like the tempo of this wine, which delivers swells of intensity in little pulses. It feels fresh on the palate with pretty fruit clarity along the way.
