

# Château Unang Ventoux



## Cinsault 2023

*The 2023 Cinsault from my favorite producer in the Ventoux, Château Unang, is crafted from vines that were planted in 2005. The vines are farmed organically and certified by Ecocert and the wine is fermented and raised in stainless steel tank. It offers up a beautifully expressive bouquet of dark berries, espresso, pepper, grilled meats, saddle leather, stony soil tones, campfire and a touch of garrigue in the upper register. On the palate the wine is fullish, wide open and complex, with a lovely core, fine soil undertow, modest tannins and lovely grip on the long, well balanced and wide open finish. This is made for early consumption and it is flat out delicious. In my old sommelier days, I would have hopped on this in a second as a wine by the glass pour! Fine juice and a great value. 2025-2035.*
