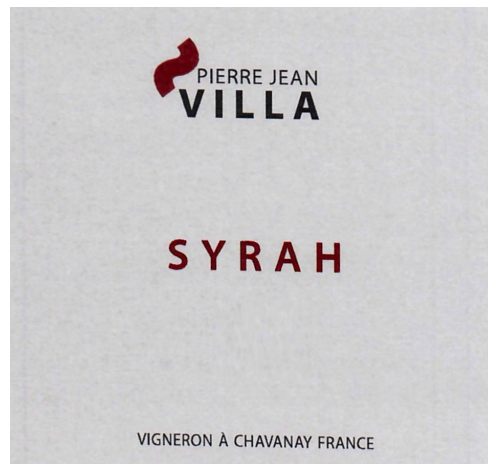


# Domaine Pierre-Jean Villa Saint Joseph



## Syrah Vin de France 2023

*This bottling of Syrah Vin de France from Pierre-Jean Villa hails primarily from parcels that were formerly part of the Saint-Joseph AOC, but which were declassified when the officials decided to shrink the appellation a bit in 2018. Pierre-Jean augments the production from these two parcels with production from younger vines in his other plots in Saint-Joseph. The wine's élevage is done in foudres. The 2023 version comes in at 13.5 percent octane and delivers a lovely bouquet of cassis, black olive, pepper, grilled meats, dark soil tones and a topnote of woodsmoke. On the palate the wine is bright, full-bodied, focused and complex, with a good core of fruit, fine soil undertow and grip, a nice chassis of tannin and fine length and grip on the well balanced finish. This is a very good bottle of syrah that will age quite nicely and is a fine, fine value. 2025-2045.*
