Gamay Noir 2023

The 2023 Gamay Noir was fermented with around 65% whole clusters and matured for 10 months in used oak. It has pure aromas of cranberry, red cherry, cracked pepper, dried herbs and earth. The light-bodied palate is bright and juicy with nuanced flavors, silky tannins and a long, layered finish. 396 cases were made.

The 2023 Gamay Noir mixes violet and rose tones over crushed blackberries to form an inviting bouquet. Its soft texture and roundness soothe with bright acidity and crisp wild berry fruit. Wildly fresh and clean, it leaves a subtle peppery resonance as tart raspberry fades.

From two sites, Björnson Vineyard in the Eola-Amity Hills and one in Van Duzer, Pamar Vineyard. Vinified using 60% whole cluster and native fermentation and semi-carbonic maceration. ‘We keep the berries pretty whole for as long as we can,’ says winemaker Chris Butler. It’s aged in neutral oak for 10 months, it’s floral and pops with bubble gum fruit that is evocative of the world’s great Gamays. The palate bursts with purple fruits, savoury mint and pine. Brilliant and exemplary.
