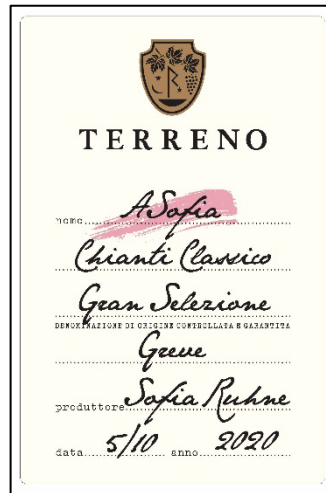


Terreno Chianti Classico



Chianti Classico Gran Selezione ASofia 2020

A restrained, pure and fresh wine with a lot of transparency. Aromas of cherry pits, fresh red cherries, red currants, violets, leather and chalky minerality. Full-bodied, it shows elegant, velvety tannins with lifted acidity and a mineral-laden finish. Drink or hold.

...The wine shows a dense mouthfeel, and the tannins are softer but also richer compared to the more focused approach that you get in the Riserva. This is a 4,000-bottle release.

ASofia has always been a single-vineyard bottling from the estate's oldest vines, and this is the first year it has been declared as Gran Selezione. In the UGA of Greve at 350 metres, the south-to-southwest facing plot is distinguished by sandy, Macigno soil. It makes for a lovely, fragrant expression of rose, plum blossom and crushed allspice. The palate is layered with supple bright berries and suede-like tannins, all making for a velvety, sumptuous texture. It finishes with a peppery snap. A splendid demonstration that the Gran Selezione category has ample room for elegantly styled wines.
