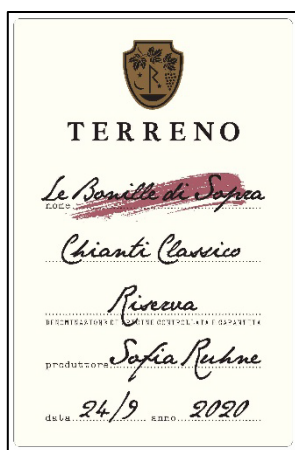


Terreno Chianti Classico

Le Bonille di Sopra Chianti Classico Riserva 2020

A complex wine with elegant aromas of Mediterranean herbs, oak bark, earth, cherry pits and restrained Parma violets. Elegant on the palate as well, this is full-bodied with velvety, almost silky tannins and long, refreshing acidity. Cedar flavors in the finish. Harmony and perfect balance in an energetic way. Drink or hold.

Le Bonille di Sopra Chianti Classico Riserva 2019

The Terreno 2019 Chianti Classico Riserva Le Bonille di Sopra is a lovely wine (with 8,000 bottles made) that delivers a core of dark fruit that is delicately framed by light spice and earth. The wine shows an especially juicy quality of fruit in this vintage, with good concentration and power to match. Tannins also play a bigger role in this wine, adding a solid vein of support at the back. The exact blend is 85% Sangiovese, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Colorino, and the wine spends 24 months in large oak casks.

Dark magenta with a tinge of purple, the 2019 Chianti Classico Riserva starts to reveal notes of sappy earth along with aromas of licorice candy, black cherry, and mossy forest floor. Generous and round on the palate, it's full-bodied without any excess weight and offers ripe, plush tannins and a good evenness of acidity, with a delicate mouthwatering touch on the finish. It's a very attractive wine to enjoy over the next few years.
