### Rully 1er Cru Clos du Chaigne 2024

*The 2024 Rully Clos du Chaigne 1er Cru Blanc comes from vines with an east orientation and is raised 60% in barrel (20% new and mainly Chassin cooperage) and 40% in stainless steel vat. This has quite a pithy bouquet with grapefruit, quince and leesy scents coming through with time. The palate is well balanced with a harmonious entry, fine acidity and clean crisp fruit with subtle tropical notes towards the refined finish. Classy.*

### Rully 1er Cru Clos St. Jacques 2024

*The 2024 Rully Clos St. Jacques 1er Cru, raised entirely in barrel, clearly has the most complexity and intensity on the nose with yellow plum, lemon verbena and light crushed white flowers scents. Very well defined. The palate is well balanced with a very harmonious entry, nicely pitched acidity, clean and pure with hints of peach and apricot towards the finish. Great potential.*

### Rully Clos de Bellecroix 2024

*The 2024 Rully Clos de Bellecroix has a light and slightly earthy bouquet and here there is a slight shortfall of red fruit, but it is clean. The palate is well balanced with pretty red cherry and strawberry fruit, certainly much more delicate with an easy-going finish. Slips down the throat with ease.*

## **Rully Clos de Bellecroix Cuvée Marey 2024**

*The 2024 Rully Clos de Bellecroix Cuvée Marey comes from the 1.6-hectare parcel that faces east and is aged with 25% new oak barrel. This has fine lift on the nose: red cherries, wild strawberry and light rose petal scents that blossom in the glass. The palate is medium-bodied with rounded tannins, soft in texture, transparent with a slight tart finish. This will be difficult, nigh impossible to resist in its youth.*

## **Rully Clos La Folie 2024**

*The 2024 Rully Clos la Folie Blanc is aged in used barrels and tank. It has pretty green apple and fresh pear scents on the fresh nose. Fine delineation, though not powerful. The palate is balanced with a rounded entry, surprising fatness on the mid-palate and here I am just seeking a little more acidic bite on the finish.*

## **Bourgogne Aligoté 2024**

*The vines that constitute the 2024 Bourgogne Aligoté are Aligoté d'Orée, planted a century ago, and the winemaking operandi here is to work the lees. It has a light bouquet that doesn't quite get both hands on the grape variety as I would like. The palate is better with a smooth texture, almost creamy, touches of pear and quince, gentle and understated towards the finish. It grows on you. Drink over four or five years.*
