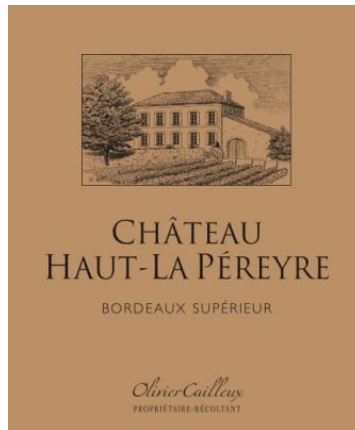


Château Haut-La Péreyre Haut-Benauge



Bordeaux Supérieur 2022

Deep ruby/plum-hued, the 2022 Château Haut-La Péreyre reveals sweet black cherries, currants, spicy wood, and chocolaty, cedar pencil-like nuances. It's medium-bodied, with a nicely balanced, textured mouthfeel, integrated tannins, and a good finish. This complex, nuanced, satisfying effort will drink well over the coming 7-8 years.

Raspberries, redcurrants and bay leaves on the nose of this fresh and fruity red. It's medium-bodied, bright and crunchy, with lightly chalky tannins. Drink from 2026.

The 2020 Château Haut-La Péreyre showed consistently, with a charming red and blue-fruited, floral, spicy character as well as medium-bodied richness and depth on the palate. Its tannins are slightly more present today, and it should keep through 2030 with ease.
