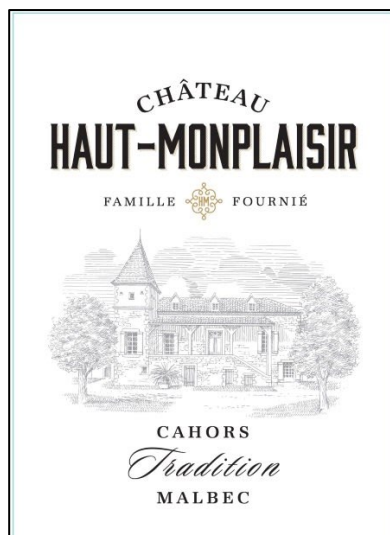


# Château Haut-Monplaisir Cahors



## Cahors Tradition 2021

*Seventy percent of this all-Malbec Cahors is aged in concrete tanks and the rest in oak barrels for a year and a half. Medium-bodied and with considerable complexity, it shows notes of juicy dark and red berries along with hints of cedar, Mediterranean herbs, eucalyptus, and orange rind. Made from organically grown grapes, it has medium tannins and good balancing acidity.*

*This wine's high-toned flavors of sour cherry and cherry pit play above a rich texture, starting bright before deepening in the finish. It elegantly conveys its depth and complexity without feeling overbearing or inaccessible. A day of air reveals some darker contours and a wild blueberry zip. Decant it with grilled sausages.*
