### St. Joseph “Tildé” 2023

*Using grapes from over 60-year-old vines grown on granitic soils at over 300 metres altitude, the 2023 Saint-Joseph Tildé lets the first fragrances drift toward black pepper, black cherry and graphite dust. Midweighted and concentrated, the 2023 reveals its class even this early on, showcasing calm refinement all the way through to the long and gently structured finish.*

### St. Joseph “Tildé” 2019

*Opaque ruby. Expressive cherry and blackberry aromas, along with hints of smoked meat, potpourri and cracked pepper. Sappy and energetic on the palate, offering expansive black and blue fruit and floral pastille flavors that deepen and become sweeter with air. Finishes very long and precise, showing excellent clarity and spicy cut on the smoky, gently tannic finish. Two-thirds whole clusters.*

*Coming from older vines and only partially destemmed, the 2019 Saint Joseph Tilde spent two years in a mix of barrels and 500-liter demi-muids before being bottled. It's another incredibly pure, balanced, polished wine from this terrific vigneron that offers classic Saint-Joseph black fruits, scorched earth, peppery herbs, and subtle smoky aromatics, medium to full body, terrific tannins, and a great finish. It's drinking brilliantly today and shows the ripe, powerful style of the vintage while also holding onto remarkable purity and freshness.*
