Cadillac Cuvée Meste-Jean 2023

Based on 77% Petit Verdot and 23% Merlot and aged in 30% French oak (400-liter barrels) with the balance in stainless steel, the 2023 Château Haut-La Péreyre Cuvée Meste-Jean offers up outstanding aromatics of ripe black fruits, chocolate, tobacco, and graphite on the nose. It's medium to full-bodied and concentrated on the palate, with ripe, textured tannins and a great finish. This beautiful wine will drink well over the coming decade. Drink 2026-2035.

Pretty, juicy, and upfront, with a very floral, complex, medium-bodied style, the 2023 Château Haut-La Péreyre Cuvée Meste-Jean offers red and black fruits, sappy herbs, underbrush, and spring flower notes. It's balanced and has moderate concentration and depth, as well as ripe tannins. This delicious and complex effort is best enjoyed over the coming 5-7 years.

Cadillac Cuvée Meste-Jean 2022

The 2022 Meste-Jean is outstanding stuff and well worth seeking out, as well as a good value. Based on 65% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, and the rest Petit Verdot, it has juicy darker cherry and berry fruit, some leafy herb nuances, medium body, and just a charming, forward, delicious style perfect for drinking through 2032.
