Engelberg Grand Cru Riesling 2023

The 2023 Riesling Engelberg Grand Cru, grown on south-facing oolitic limestone and picked in October, opens with creamy, pear-and-peach-scented notions of wet stone, still with a touch of reduction. The palate is smooth, light and bright, tapering to a super-slender finish that is taut, graceful and linear. This creates a superb sense of elegance and length on this understated, bone-dry Riesling. (Bone-Dry)

Engelberg Grand Cru Riesling 2021

The 2021 Riesling Engelberg Grand Cru was harvested a month later than its 2022 counterpart. The nose has a subtle edge of quince peel and its autumnal notions of heightened aromatics. The palate is taut and bright, almost with a veil of slightly drying tannins. This wine is so fresh and bright. The oolitic limestone keeps everything cool, slender, taut and fresh as dew. (Bone-Dry)
