

2024 Chenin Blanc - Rogue Valley

Notes of mangoes and nectarines, saltwater taffy, alpine strawberry, sweetgrass.

This is definitely our unicorn varietal - very hard to come by and we're holding on for dear life.

We started

working with this fruit in 2019 and feel very fortunate to know this site quite well. The amazing thing

about this vineyard is it sits darn near the CA border in the town of Talent, and soaks up ample sunshine

(note the 13.5% abv here) during its growing season. However, being at 1900 feet elevation and tucked

into the Wagner Creek Basin, this fruit steadily ripens during the day but dramatically pauses at night,

retaining those high acids. (pH here is 3.2!)

100% stainless steel fermented and rested. Non GMO yeast. Dry. L.i.v.e practicing.
