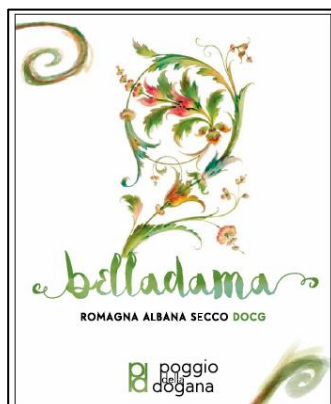


Poggio della Dogana Romagna



Belladama Romagna Albana Secco 2023

The Belladama Bianco bottling from the Rametta brothers' Poggio della Dogana is made entirely from the Albana grape. The wine is fermented and raised in stainless steel tanks for seven or eight months prior to bottling. The 2023 Belladama Bianco offers up beautifully deep and complex nose of pear, a touch of green olive, lemon peel, lovely soil tones and a topnote of chamomile. On the palate the wine is vibrant, full-bodied and zesty, with a beautiful core of fruit, fine mineral drive and grip, a superb spine of acidity and lovely balance on the long, complex and nicely precise finish. This is an excellent wine that will continue to age many, many years, but is drinking superbly right now. It is a great value! 2026-2040.

Toasted apple skins and sunny yellow flowers set the stage for this skin-contact charmer. The time on skins shows its hand with a pleasant grip and texture, while a medley of pears and apples dance across the palate. A splash of lemon zips through at just the right moment, keeping everything lively and bright.
