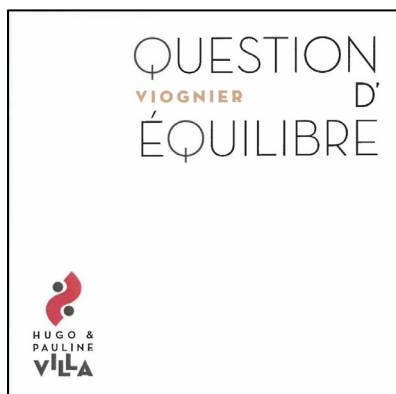

Viognier “Question d’Équilibre” 2024

Crafted entirely from Viognier, the 2024 Vin de Pays des Collines Rhodaniennes Question d’Équilibre is elegant and perfumed, revealing aromas of apricot, ripe orchard fruits and honeysuckle. Moderately weighted and round, it’s supple and juicy, built around a fresh core of fruit, concluding with a short, perfumed finish.

Viognier “Question d’Équilibre” 2023

The 2023 Viognier “Question d’Équilibre” from Hugo and Pauline Villa is crafted with an eye towards retaining freshness and balance in the wine, rather than going for the power one finds too often in Viognier today. One-third of the cuvée is raised in older demi-muids and the other two-thirds in stainless steel tanks. The wine is a spry thirteen percent octane in this vintage and offers up a lovely aromatic constellation of pear, tangerine, a touch of fresh pineapple, honeysuckle, granitic minerality and a nice topnote of coriander seed. On the palate the wine is bright, complex and full-bodied, with a lovely succulent core of fruit, excellent soil undertow, bouncy acids and a long, well balanced and nicely precise finish. This is excellent viognier and a stellar value! 2025-2030+.
