### St. Joseph “Tildé” 2023

*Perfumed and harmonious, Villa’s 2023 Saint-Joseph Tilde is showing well, wafting from the glass with aromas of dark berries, dark cherries, violet, lead pencil and a touch of raspberry. Medium to full-bodied, dense and concentrated, it’s suave and seamless, built around a delicate, velvety tannic frame that segues into a long, delicate and perfumed finish. It will benefit from two to four years in the cellar before opening.*

*Using grapes from over 60-year-old vines grown on granitic soils at over 300 metres altitude, the 2023 Saint-Joseph Tildé lets the first fragrances drift toward black pepper, black cherry and graphite dust. Midweighted and concentrated, the 2023 reveals its class even this early on, showcasing calm refinement all the way through to the long and gently structured finish.*

### St. Joseph “Tildé” 2019

*Opaque ruby. Expressive cherry and blackberry aromas, along with hints of smoked meat, potpourri and cracked pepper. Sappy and energetic on the palate, offering expansive black and blue fruit and floral pastille flavors that deepen and become sweeter with air. Finishes very long and precise, showing excellent clarity and spicy cut on the smoky, gently tannic finish. Two-thirds whole clusters.*

*Ripe and focused, with a beam of dark cherry and blackberry compote flavors flanked by a graphite note. Finish has a nice tug of tar to give it some weight. 300 cases made.*
