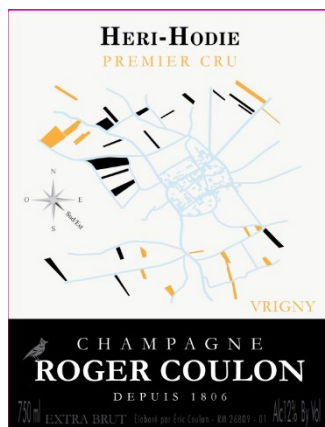


Champagne Roger Coulon Vrigny

Roger Coulon: A precious address for fine champagnes, between purity and elegance, where the dynamism of the new generation perfectly blends with the know-how of the experienced.

A Latin name meaning “yesterday to today,” the NV Champagne Heri-Hodie Premier Cru is their perpetual reserve of Meunier, 90% from the Premier Cru, with the addition of 10% Chardonnay. Coming from 2021, with 3 grams per liter dosage, it pours a bright straw hue and is savory with aromatics of red cherry fruit, saline, and fresh flowers. Full-bodied, it has wonderful intensity and a fresh lift of salty earth on the long persistent finish, with a note of orange zest, a lively mousse, and a rounded mouthfeel with nice purity of black fruit.

Roger Coulon's wines took my breath away, across the board. This 'entry' wine was thrilling. Quince, loquat, brine and edging towards kombucha and oolong tea and texture.
