Chablis 2024

Pale lemon and lime. Attractively perfumed, the minerals follow in the mouth, racy and typical. Long finish with a bit of clean citrus. Drink from 2026-2028.

Chablis La Grande Chaume 2024

100% in wood this year. Fuller in colour and not clear, so harder to taste. A significant volume of fruit, with good acidity, but the detail is hidden by a recent stirring. Drink from 2027-2030.

Chablis Clos du Château 2024

No wood used this year. More of a full lemon colour. The Clos du Château has a fair volume of fruit, less floral than the straight Chablis, but the minerality is striking at the back of the palate. Drink from 2027-2029.

Chablis Mont de Milieu 1er Cru 2024

Pale lemon. This is racing and addictive. A little bit of citrus, a crunchy white fruit, juicy on the one hand, strict on the other. Very well balanced. Drink from 2028-2033.

Chablis Mont de Milieu 1er Cru Vieilles Vignes 2024

More depth of colour and evident wood on the nose. Significant acidity behind, the centre exists but is hidden between the two ends at the moment. Drink from 2028-2034.
