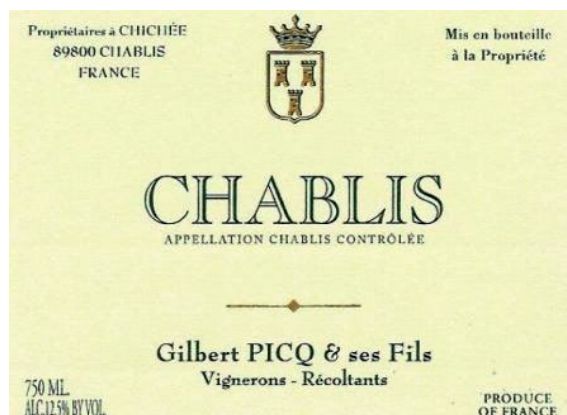


Gilbert Picq & ses Fils Chablis



Chablis 2024

Clear fresh colour, really racy on the nose, the best of the more vibrant side of 2024. Really invigorating, almost lime juice at the finish, plus coquillage character. Evidently no 2023 wine has been added back in at this domaine! Drink from 2026-2029.

The Chablis villages cuvée was the only 2024 already in bottle, so this was the sole representative of the vintage chez Picq that we tasted during my visit. It is made from twelve different parcels of vines and thus, is a very fine example of the entire Chablis appellation. The wine offers up a beautiful nose of lemon, pear, chalky minerality, a touch of straw, citrus peel and a topnote of fruit blossoms. On the palate the wine is deep, full-bodied, crisp and complex, with a superb core of fruit, lovely mineral drive and cut, zesty acids and impeccable balance on the long and complex finish. Fine, fine juice. 2026-2045+.

Chablis Vaudécorse 2024

Vaudécorse occupies the next slope south of Vaucoupin. Here the vines came out very well without much damage. More lemon in the colour. The same tension, lemon and lime intensity, just a little more intensity than the village wine, good grip here once again. Drink from 2027-2030.

Chablis Vieilles Vignes 2024

A bright mid yellow colour, plenty of energy, Coquillage-plus with the same lemon scent I am often finding in 2024. A little softer and richer than the previous wines but still fundamentally chiselled. Drink from 2027-2030.

Chablis Dessus La Carrière 2024

A little paler in colour, with a beautifully classy marine white fruit nose. Less of the overpowering citrus, maybe just a little finger lime at the finish. Fine and persistent, very successful. The yield was barely 25 hl/ha, the quality exceptional. Drink from 2028-2032.

Chablis Vauclaire 2024

Pale lemon yellow. A little stricter on the nose, but not sulphur, more Kimmeridge. Less gracious at the moment but a brilliant concentrated, Chablis intensity. Stirring stuff. Drink from 2027-2030.

Chablis 1er Cru Vosgros 2024

Vaussegros was the old spelling, which is why the first 'S' is pronounced. Pale lemon colour. Didier seems to have stolen all the coquilles from others because he has an exceptional amount in his wines this year. More salty than citrus. Much less flesh than usual but that is not necessarily a bad thing. Drink from 2028-2033.

Chablis 1er Cru Vaucoupin 2024

Pale in colour, offering fresh white fruit, very nicely on the stones, with that reductive crunchy finish. Quite long, suavely sensual, not too trenchant but with energy. Drink from 2028-2033.
