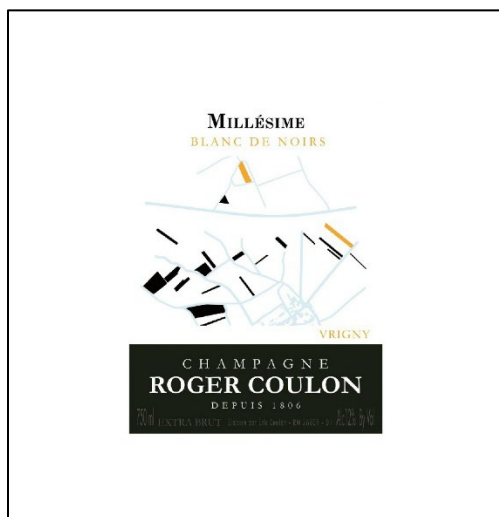


Champagne Roger Coulon Vrigny



Millésime Blanc de Noirs Extra Brut 2014

Coulon's 2014 Blanc de Noirs Millésime, disgorged in July 2023 with a dosage of two grams per liter, is, as ever, a blend of ungrafted Pinot Meunier rooted in sandy soils and old-vine Pinot Noir. It soars from the glass with aromas of orange oil, buttery pastry, dried apricot and iris mingled with subtle nuances of mocha and nashi pear. Medium- to full-bodied and rich yet incisive, it is underpinned by a racy spine of acidity and has a saline profile, culminating in a long, citrus-inflected finish. This is a wine in fine form and well worth a special effort to seek out.
