



Enchanted Way Vineyard Chardonnay 2024

The 2024 Chardonnay Enchanted Way Vineyard opens with a whiff of tropical citrus and florals complicated by a tinge of exotic spice. It's silken in feel, with weighty textures and elegantly ripe pit fruits over a stream of fresh acidity. Nuances of chamomile linger over a salty flourish as the 2024 finishes long, with lovely inner tension. 2026-2030.

Freedom Hill Vineyard Pinot Blanc 2024

Mark Vlossak's 2024 Pinot Blanc from the Freedom Hill Vineyard is raised in a combination of a twenty-five percent stainless steel tanks and three-quarters in Acacia wood foudres, with the two components blended after eight months of aging on their own. The 2024 bottling is quite lovely, marrying fine fruit tones with the gentle influence of the acacia barrels. The bouquet wafts from the glass in a complex blend of pear, almond, white soil tones, spring flowers and acacia wood. On the palate the wine is bright, full-bodied and complex, with a lovely core of fruit, good soil signature and grip, zesty acids and perhaps just a whisper of backend tannin from the acacia foudres. This is a lovely wine that is already drinking well, but has lovely potential to age. 2026-2036.

Temperance Hill Vineyard Riesling 2024

As I mentioned last year, Mark Vlossak crafts his Riesling like a drier-styled Kabinett, picking the grapes early to keep the wine light and fermenting to nearly full dryness. Temperance Hill is one of the coolest vineyards in Oregon and the block of Riesling, which was planted at Mark's urging, sits at the very crest of the hillside vineyard in its coolest section. The wine is fermented and raised in stainless steel, with the 2024 version tipping the scales at 10.5 percent alcohol and delivering a beautifully complex bouquet of pear, apple, salty soil tones, white flowers, bee pollen and a touch of incipient honeycomb. On the palate the wine is bright, medium-full, complex and zesty, with lovely intensity of flavor, fine soil signature and grip, an excellent spine of acidity and a long, poised and beautifully balanced finish. This is absolutely lovely this year! 2026-2045.

Villages Cuvée Pinot Noir 2024

The 2024 Pinot Noir Villages Cuvée opens with a pretty blend of dusty rose, white pepper, cedary spice and wild strawberries. Juicy to the core, the palate offers lively acidity and pure wild berry fruit, elevated by hints of blood orange, while an inner herbal flourish adds complexity. Pleasantly chewy and long, the 2024 Pinot Noir Villages Cuvée leaves a subtle licorice tinge on the clean, crisp finish. 2026-2030.
